

Adjustable Wrench 5/16" Hex Driver Bit Cordless Drill Pipe Thread Sealant RTV Silicone

INSTALLATION

- Remove the CSL fixture from the packaging taking care not to damage the fixture or the finish. Mounting hardware is provided.
- Remove Clamp Nut (with O-Ring Seal), Clamping Plate and Clamping Plate Gasket from the threaded hub. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REMOVE ½-14 NPS THREADED STEM. This component is bonded to the fixture and wires are potted internally to the housing from the factory.
- 3. Working from below the canopy, mark and cut out wire way hole for fixture installation. A minimum of 2-1/4" diameter hole is required in the canopy, centered between two canopy ribs. WARNING: Wire way hole must not exceed 4" diameter.
- 4. For canopy deck mounting, align the fixture in final mounting position and insert and tighten the four (4) supplied #12 Self Drilling SS Screws and four (4) EPDM Bonded SS Sealing Washers as shown in **FIGURE 1** into metal ceiling. If ceiling isn't metal use appropriate customer supplied hardware. For structural channel mounting, go straight to Step 5.
- Working above the canopy/structural channel, install the Clamping Plate Gasket, Clamping Plate and Clamp Nut (with O-Ring Seal) and tighten to compress gasket against the canopy. See FIGURE 2 for canopy deck mounting, FIGURE 3 for structural channel mounting.
- Apply thread sealant to stem and attach the customer supplied wet location junction box with ½"-14 pipe openings to the threaded stem, pull supply conductors into the junction box. Install hole plugs for structural channel mounting, FIGURE 3.
- Wire fixture and close junction box with gasketed cover. Perform all supply power wiring per NEC and local code using suitable wiring connectors (provided by others).
- Apply RTV silicone to all 4 screw penetrations on top of canopy deck.



INSTALLATION

- Remove the CSL fixture from the packaging taking care not to damage the fixture or the finish. Mounting hardware is provided.
- Remove ½"-14 Brass Hex Nut and 7/8" Flat Washer. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REMOVE COMPOSITE ½-14 NPS THREADED STEM. This component is bonded to the fixture and wires are potted internally to the housing from the factory.
- Working from below the canopy, mark and cut out a 1.00" hole thru lower and upper canopy skins. Using hole saw cut a 2.00"Ø hole in lower interior skin to clear hub.
- Align the fixture in final mounting position and insert and tighten the four (4) supplied #12 Self Drilling SS Screws and four (4) EPDM Bonded SS Sealing Washers as shown in FIGURE 1.
- Working above the canopy, install the ½"-14 Brass Hex Nut and 7/8" Flat Washer and tighten until it presses firmly against the canopy See FIGURE 2.
- Apply thread sealant to stem and attach the customer supplied wet location junction box with ½"-14 pipe openings to the threaded stem, pull supply conductors into the junction box.
- Wire fixture and close junction box with gasketed cover. Perform all supply power wiring per NEC and local code using suitable wiring connectors (provided by others).
- 8. Apply RTV silicone where the threaded stem penetrates the Brass Hex Nut and Flat Washer.





INSTALLATION

- 2. Remove the splice box wire access cover and set aside.
- 3. Attach the splice box to the ³⁄₄" pendant (by others) and thread the ³⁄₄"-14 NPS hub onto the pendant. See FIGURE 1. Make sure a locknut (by others) is threaded on to the pendant prior to mounting the splice box. Orient the splice box so that the fixture will be squared as desired. Re-orientation of the splice box may be done by either loosening the pendant lock nut or by loosening the provided hub locknut inside the splice box. 


